<p>Under the Convention on Biological Diversity, the Kunming – Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework provides an ambitious roadmap to advance its vision of “a world of living in harmony with nature where “by 2050, biodiversity is valued, conserved, restored and wisely used, maintaining ecosystem services, sustaining a healthy planet and delivering benefits essential for all people.” Within this framework, the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan 2025 -2030 is a key policy instrument that, combined with sustainable production strategies, provides a blueprint for an enhanced agriculture-based production.
